- Cell phone usage is strictly limited for reading Bible passages and taking a quick video or picture of something going on at youth. You can upload the picture or video later, but please refrain from doing so in youth. No one should break this rule, not even adults. If there is an emergency you need to handle, please step into the hall. Emergencies will not be allowed to occur every week.



- Get engaged in what is going on. Raise your hand to answer a question (off topic is not allowed). During games cheer for those participating. Sing during worship. You get out of youth what you put in.
- Register in advance for youth activities. Do not wait until the last minute, because after deadline adds will not be allowed.
